Hugh MacInnis son of Angus Ban MacInnis, Arisaig Scotland came out to Pictou about the year 1791, settled for a short time in Merigomish, then moved to Cape George. Many hardships were endured ie: Hugh MacInns and some of his neighbours had to go in winter along the shore to Merigomish for salt. The trip would take three days to complete. They would carry home large sacks of salt on their backs. Hugh MacInnis owned the first axe at Cape George. It was made for him by the first Blacksmith in the town of Antigonish. Imagine, sometimes they walked across the ice on St Georges Bay to Judique in search of a wife. The sun glare was so strong that they were nearly blind when they reached Judique. Decendents of those MacInnis's are still living in the Cape George Area.
