

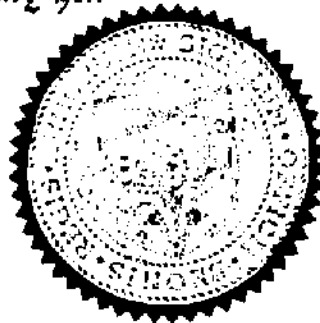


## EXTRACTS of MATRICULATION of the Arms of WILLIAM JOHN MacINNIS.

WILLIAM JOHN MacINNIS, Attorney and Counsellor at Law, sometime Mayor of Gloucester in the State of Massachusetts, United States of America, residing at 8 Frowey Street there having by Petition unto the Lord Lyon King of Arms of date 7 May 1900 SHOWN; THAT he, the Petitioner (who married 1918 Florence Lyman daughter of Walter Clarence Bemis and has with other issue a son and heir William John MacInnis, younger of that name) is the eldest son of Muedoch MacInnis, Master Mariner, born Malagawatch, Port Fastings, Cape Breton, Nova Scotia, Canada, September 1842 and died at sea whilst in command of the schooner "Zetion" 1 June 1895, who resided at Gloucester, Massachusetts, and his wife Mary Louise daughter of Norman MacDonald, born in North List which he left to settle at Enon, Cape Breton, and his wife Margaret MacVicar; THAT the Petitioner's said father was the seventh son of Muedoch MacInnis, born 1800 in the Isle of Skye which he left, sailing from Oban aboard the "Beclor" in 1820 to settle at Malagawatch aforesaid, and his wife Catherine MacLeod; THAT Arms are recorded as for the said last mentioned Muedoch MacInnis in the Public Register of All Arms and Bearings in Scotland (Vol. 44, page 79) of date 24 July 1900; AND the Petitioner having prayed that the said arms might be recorded of new in his own name with his due and congruent difference, The Lord Lyon King of Arms by Interlocutor of date 24 July 1900 Granted Warrant to the Lyon Clerk to matriculate in the Public Register of All Arms and Bearings in Scotland in name of the Petitioner the following Ensigns Memorial, videlicet:— Quarterly; 1st, Azure, a castle of two towers Or, port and windows Gules;— 2nd and 3rd, Or, upon a sea in base undy Azure and Argent, a rymmed Vex, flagged and five visible sails in action Gules; 4th Argent, a saltire Or; over all, dividing the quarters, a cross Vex charged with a mill wheel proper four masons Argent, accompanied by two cross-crosslets in the flanks, and as many cross-crosslets difference in chief and in base of the said cross all of the last; all within a border Sable for difference. Above the Shield is placed an Helm befitting his degree, with a Mantling Azure doubled Or, and on a Wreath of the Diversities is set for Crest a sinister arm from the shoulder bendways, attired in a close sleeve of the proper color of the Clan Longhair, videlicet:— Yellow 4 (Pivot) Black 25, Green 4, Black 4, Green 4, Black 4, Green 32, Black 6, Azure 6, Black 6, Blue 24, Green 12, Red 4 (Centre Pivot) cuff flashes Yellow with three buttons Or, grasping a bow Vex, stanged Gules, and in an Escrol over the same this Motto GIFTS DRE AGUS ON RIGH

Matriculated the 25th day of January 1901.
